

CASS KING and **John Woods** also performed at Bukowski's Sunday as the sometimes audacious and invariably droll WetSpots.

Woods is best known for a continuing 10-year stint with the Orchid Highway pop group, and King for organizing and participating in countless poetry and spoken-word performances, competitions, festivals and the like.

They describe their musical-comedy act — see and hear at www.wetspotsmusic.com — as “Triple XXX without using any words that aren't allowed on CBC Radio.” Indeed, the public broadcaster — and especially Britain's BBC — might air their very risible *Smack My Bottom*. But it would likely blanch at an even funnier one that urges autoerotic men to not toy with objects that may need to be removed — Ms. King's given

These and five other songs appear on the WetSpots' CD, *Ribbed For Pleasure*, with a full-length album reportedly in the works.
